Parent Teacher Communication

At present we are using the DOJO system to communicate with parents. Unfortunately, many staff are being constantly swamped with messages from parents, some late in the evening, many over the weekend and some before 7-00am in the morning. These are often trivial information requests such as, what time is the show, does he need to bring his trainers, could you help look for her coat, he can't find his homework, can she go to Kidz Club tonight or he's not feeling well so he won't be in school today. It's not uncommon for staff to be receiving 20-30 messages each evening . They have now been advised not to respond.

It is important for the health and well-being of staff, that when they are off-duty from 5-00pm until 8-00am (with the exception of planning and marking) they are not bombarded with messages.

The staff work incredibly hard and it is really important that they have time to switch off and enjoy a good work/life balance.
