### Parking along Carr Moss Lane

I have been contacted on several occasions recently by residents of Carr Moss Lane.

They are rightly concerned about inconsiderate parking during the drop-off and pick-up parts of the school day. As well as dangerously parking right on the T-Junction by the main road, there are also cars that park illegally on yellow lines and some also block driveways.

Residents concerns have been relayed to the police so please be aware that on-the-spot fines may well be issued if officers decide to monitor the area.

Please park considerately so as not to inconvenience local residents. Thank you.
