Year 5 PGL

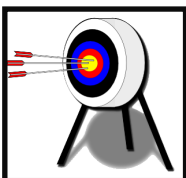
The year 5 children spent 2 days at the Winmarleigh Hall PGL camp this week and have just returned this Friday afternoon. They had an amazing time.

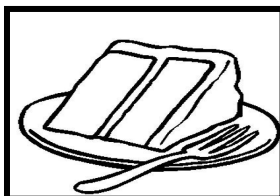
Strawberry Teas
