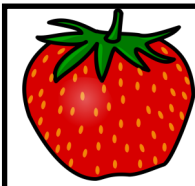


Strawberry Teas

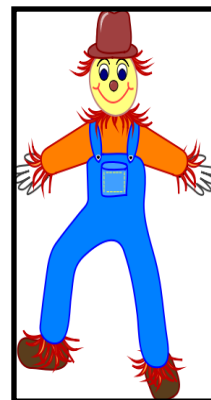
Tag Rugby
